I certify that on the night of the 9th of February 1863 whilst encamped at Jumping Branch in Mercer County Virginia my camp was attacked by a superior force of the enemy and compelled to evacuate the town in the night. on the morning of the 10th Private Wm R. Jacobs with some twenty others were ordered to recapture the town and whilst so engaged the party were surprised by a large body of the enemys cavalry and the said Wm R. Jacobs was captured together with his horse and that the above horse was valued at Eighty five dollars
