Pursuant to an Order from the County Court of Kanawha County dated at March Term 1823. Directed to Charles Kenall, William Tompkins, Tobias Ruffner, Andrew Parks and James Wilson or any three of them for the purpose of dividing the Estate of John Vanbiller dec<sup>d</sup> in the hands of Co<sup>s</sup>. Andrew Lonnally and James Vanbiller adm<sup>rs</sup> of the said Estate. We the Under signed according to the foregoing Order of Court after being duly sworn, have proceeded to make the division of said Estate in the following manner that is to say, To Co<sup>s</sup>. Andrew Lonnally Lot 1<sup>st</sup> consisting of one negro man named Anthony valued at \$450 - to receive from Lot 2<sup>nd</sup> \$20 &c - To James Vanbiller Lot 2<sup>nd</sup> consisting of one negro man named Philm. valued at \$450 - to receive from Lot 1<sup>st</sup> \$20 &c - To Hannah slaughter Lot 3<sup>rd</sup> consisting of negro boy Seremist and Lucy daughter of Celina valued at \$450 - To the Representatives of Celice Loper Lot 4<sup>th</sup> consisting of Celice her child Clarissa and Malinda in the hands of James Vanbiller valued at \$450 - to receive from Lot 1<sup>st</sup> \$20 &c - To Miriam Reynolds Lot 5<sup>th</sup> consisting of one negro boy Nathan Malinda daughter of Celice & Mary in the hands of James Vanbiller valued at \$450 - All witness our hands this 13<sup>th</sup> day of March 1823.
