

# Bible Timeline

2126 BC	Terah begets Haran, Nahor, Abram (Gen 11:26)
1921 BC	Abram & Lot go to Canaan from Haran (Turkey)
1919	Famine strikes, the family goes to Egypt
1917	Return from Egypt to Bethel (Canaan = Israel, including Hagar)
1910	Ishmael is born to Abram & Hagar, Sarai's Egyptian handmaid
1916	Abram & Lot part ways; Lot to plains of Sodom
1898	Promise to Abram (reminder);
1898	Sodom & Gomorrah destroyed
1896	Isaac born to Abraham & Sarah
1871	Isaac nearly sacrificed on Mt. Moriah
1853	Sarah dies.
1836	Jacob (& Esau) born to Isaac & Rebekah
1752	Jacob m. Leah (1) Rachel (2) in Haran, returns to Canaan.
1751	Jacob's name changed to ISRAEL, Prince of God
1748	Judah born.

\*Lineage of Judah to King David: Judah (Judas) > Perez (Phares) > Hezron (Esrom) > Ram (Amram) > Amminadab (Aminadab) > Nahshon (Naasson) > Salma (Salmon) > Boaz (Booz) > Obed > Ishai aka Jesse > David (1 Chron 2 = Hebrew translations. The names in Matthew (parentheses) are Greek translations.

## SOLOMON'S TEMPLE 1004 - 588 BC

1012 BC	foundation erected
1004	Dedication
971	pillaged by Shishak
856	repaired by Joash
740	profaned by Ahaz
726	restored by Hezekiah (2 Chron 29)
*753 BC-476 AD, Roman government established	
588 BC	temple pillaged by Nebuchadnezzar of Babylon; many Jews captured.
458	Ezra goes to Jerusalem to rebuild temple (from Persia, 7th year of Artaxerxes)
445	Nehemiah goes to Jerusalem to build the Walls (@Susa, 20th year of Artaxerxes: 1 Nisan; Neh 2:8, Dan 9:25)
	7 Weeks or 49 Years
396 BC	Jerusalem restored. Temple restored. OT Canon completed. End of Daniel's 69 weeks Bible is silent 434 years ( <i>Protestant denominations do not consider the Apocrypha as Scripture</i> ).
167 BC	Antiochus Epiphanes desecrates Temple (2 Maccabees) see: Apocrypha + Josephus
140 BC	Hasmonean Dynasty (Maccabees) rule Israel
63 BC	Rome conquers Israel
~ 2 BC	Birth of Yeshua the Messiah in Bethlehem-Ephrathah (Matt 1, Luke 3)
~ Jan 10, 1 BC	Death of Herod the Great (following the Lunar Eclipse on 1/10)
~ 33 AD	Crucifixion, resurrection of Yeshua under Pontius Pilot (14 Nisan/7 April)
70 AD	Jerusalem, Temple destroyed by Rome; many Jews taken captive or dispersed (diaspora) to other countries.
~ 135 AD	The Roman Emperor Hadrian called Israel/Judea "Syria-Palestina" (after the defeated Philistines (Greeks), enemy of the Jews), as an insult.
